Topic: God's Attributes

Attribute: Holy (perfect moral purity)

Name of God: Kadosh (the Holy One)

Text: Leviticus 20:26 (cf I Peter 1:15)

And ye shall be holy unto me: for I the LORD am holy, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be mine. [KJV]

Psalm 99:9

Exalt the LORD our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the LORD our God is holy. [KJV]

Isaiah 6:3

And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. [KJV]

Isaiah 40:25

To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One. [KJV]

I Peter 1:15 (cf Leviticus 20:26)

But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; [KJV]

I Peter 1:16 (cf Leviticus 20:26; I Peter 1:15)

Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. [KJV]

Revelation 4:8

And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. [KJV]

Revelation 15:4

Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: [KJV]

Application # 1: Things holy by association with God.

Exodus 3:5 (cf Joshua 5:15) [holy ground]

And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground. [KJV]

Exodus 35:19 [holy garments]

The cloths of service, to do service in the holy place, the holy garments for Aaron the priest, and the garments of his sons, to minister in the priest's office. [KJV]

Leviticus 6:25 [holy offering]

Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt ^{offering} is killed shall the sin offering be killed before the LORD: it is most holy. [KJV]

Leviticus 6:27 [whatever the sin offering touches shall be holy]

Whatsoever shall touch the flesh thereof shall be holy: and when there is sprinkled of the blood thereof upon any garment, thou shalt wash that whereon it was sprinkled in the holy place. [KJV]

Ezekiel 45:4 [a consecrated place; holy land and a holy place for the sanctuary¹]

The holy portion of the land shall be for the priests the ministers of the sanctuary, which shall come near to minister unto the LORD: and it shall be a place for their houses, and an holy place for the sanctuary. [KJV]

Note: sanctuary¹: A house consecrated to the worship of God.

Application # 2: Believers are a temple indwelt by God.

John 14:15-17 [believers are indwelt by the Holy Spirit]

15 If ye love me, keep my commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever; 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. [KJV]

I Corinthians 3:16 [the believer is the temple of God indwelt by the Holy Spirit³]

(cf I Corinthians 6:19)

Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? [KJV]

I Corinthians 3:17 [the temple of God, the believer, is holy]

If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are. [KJV]

I Corinthians 6:19 [the believer's body is the temple of the Holy Spirit] cf I Cor 3:16

What? know ye not that your body is the temple *of the Holy Ghost* which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? [KJV]

II Corinthians 6:16 [the believer is the temple of God]

And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for you are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. [KJV]

Colossians 1:25-27 [the "mystery" of Christ² dwelling in the believer]

Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God; 26 Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: 27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: [KJV]

I John 4:15 [God the Father¹ indwells the believer]

Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God. [KJV]
