Name of God:

Text: Deuteronomy 32:4 [God is just]

He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, **just** and right is he.

Nehemiah 9:33 [God has done right; man has done wickedly]

Howbeit you are **just** in all that is brought upon us; for you have done right, but we have done wickedly:

Job 4:17 [God more just than man]

Shall mortal man be more **just** than God? shall a man be more pure than his maker?

Proverbs 16:11 [the LORD has a just weight]

A **just** weight and balance are the LORD'S: all the weights of the bag are his work.

Isaiah 45:21 [a Just God and Savior]

Tell, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who has declared this from ancient time? who has told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; a **just** God and a Savior; there is none beside me.

Zephaniah 3:5 [the Just Lord stands in the midst of iniquity]

The **just** LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning he brings his judgment to light, he fails not; but the unjust knows no shame.

Zechariah 9:9 [a King bringing salvation]

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, your King comes to you: he is **just**, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Matthew 27:24 [Declared Just by Pilate]

When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this **just** person: see to it.

Acts 3:14 [Condemned to death]

But you denied the Holy One and the **Just**, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

Acts 7:52 [Came to earth]

Which of the prophets have your fathers not persecuted? and they have slain them which showed before of the coming of the **Just** One; of whom you have now been the betrayers and murderers:

Acts 22:14 [Spoke to His "sent ones"]

And he said, The God of our fathers hath chosen you [Paul], that you should know his will, and see that **Just** One, and should hear the voice of his mouth.

James 5:6 [Condemned and killed]

You have condemned and killed the **just**; and he does not resist you.

I Peter 3:18 [Died for our sins]

For Christ also has once suffered for sins, the **just** for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

I John 1:9 [Forgives sin]

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and **just** to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Application: We can trust that God wants good for us and not evil.
