

## Music Policy

Adopted 7/22/18

- 1. The Goal Of Music: The goal of music at SBC is to glorify God, edify believers, and communicate truth to all
- 2. The Role Of The Music Committee: To work with the pastor to
  - a. Schedule special music
  - b. Enlist accompaniment
  - c. Enlist worship leaders
  - d. Define music policy
- 3. Guidelines For Music At SBC
  - a. Musical selections should be sound in biblical doctrine
  - b. Musical selections should not be controversial, but rather should be something meant to build up the body, not just individual members
- 4. Guidelines For Special Music
  - a. Generally, special music will be done by members and watch care members
  - b. On occasion, non-members may participate as well, provided that they are well-known and agreeable to the music committee
  - c. Use of church accompanists is preferred. However, pre-recorded music may be also used, providing it meets the guidelines for church music listed above
  - d. If there are questions about musical selection, the music committee should be consulted
- 5. Guidelines for congregational music
  - a. Musical style may vary from hymns to newer songs, but in the interest of edifying all, balance is the goal
  - b. Accompaniment may vary, but should lean conservative in nature
  - c. Only members and watch care will lead congregational singing and provide musical accompaniment
