Topic: Thanksgiving

Text: I Chronicles 16:8
Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. [KJV]

I Chronicles 16:34
O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endureth forever. [KJV]

Ezra 3:11
And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. [KJV]

Psalms 30:4
Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. [KJV]

Psalms 30:12
To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee forever. [KJV]

Psalms 35:17, 18
Lord, how long wilt thou look on? Rescue my soul from their destructions, my darling from the lions. ¹⁸ I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people. [KJV]

Psalms 92:1
A Psalm or Song for the Sabbath day. It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High: [KJV]

Psalms 105:1
O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people. [KJV]

Psalms 106:1 (cf Psalms 107:1; 118:1; 118:29; 136:1)
Praise ye the LORD. O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth forever. [KJV]

Daniel 6:10

Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. [KJV]

Matthew 15:36 (cf Mark 8:6; John 6:11)

And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude. [KJV]

Matthew 26:27 (cf Mark 14:23; Luke 22:17, 19; I Corinthians 11:24)

And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, **Drink ye all of it;** [KJV]

Acts 27:35

And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken it, he began to eat. [KJV]

II Corinthians 1:11

Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift bestowed upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf. [KJV]

II Corinthians 9:14, 15

And by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you. 15 Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift. [KJV]

Ephesians 1:16 (cf I Thessalonians 1:2)

[I] cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; [KJV]

Ephesians 5:20

Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; [KJV]

Colossians 1:3

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, [KJV]

Colossians 1:12

Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: [KJV]

Colossians 3:17

And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him. [KJV]

I Thessalonians 5:18

In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. [KJV]

I Timothy 2:1

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; [KJV]

Hebrews 13:15

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. [KJV]

Revelation 11:17

Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned. [KJV]

Application: Because of who God is and what He has done for us, we should not only give thanks to Him verbally, we should learn to live in an attitude of thankfulness.
